




Dark Side of Family Life

1. Domestic Violence

Causes Dobash and Dobash (1980)

- Wife not performing duties to husband's satisfaction
- Women forced to stay
 - Poverty
 - Economic dependence on man
 - Stigma

Data

- Reliability**
 - Unreported
 - Unrecorded by police
- Validity**
 - Private institution
 - Secret activity
 - Deliberately hidden
 - Increase?
 - More media / police activity
 - More reporting by victims

Research Evidence

- Dobash and Dobash (1980)
 - Scotland
 - 25% of ALL assaults
- UN Women's Conference (1995)
 - 25% of world's women suffer
 - India: 5 women burned to death / day
 - 1 million new born girls killed each year
 - Genital mutilation
 - Women
 - 2/3rds world's work
 - Earn 1/10 world's income
 - Own <1/100th world's property
 - Lower pay rates

Solutions

- Connors (1992)
 - Free legal advice
 - Attitude changes
 - Police
 - Judiciary / Courts
- Refuges for women / children
- Educational programmes


Explanations

- Structural**
 - Feminism
 - Marxism
 - "Invisibility of battered women"
 - Social isolation of women
 - Police inaction
 - Family=private institution
- Individual**
 - Cheal (1991)
 - Key ideological myths
 - Personal interests of women less important than family role
 - "Women free to leave"
 - Private institution



2. Rape within Marriage

- Legal**
 - Until 1991 in UK
- Prosecution Rare**
- Connors (1992)
 - Few societies penalise marital rape
 - Some societies kill women for adultery
- Feminism**
 - Male power
 - Tyrannisation
 - Patriarchy


Mental illness 'pathology' Damaged individuals' Psycho-pathological
